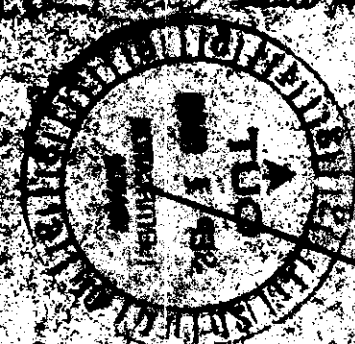

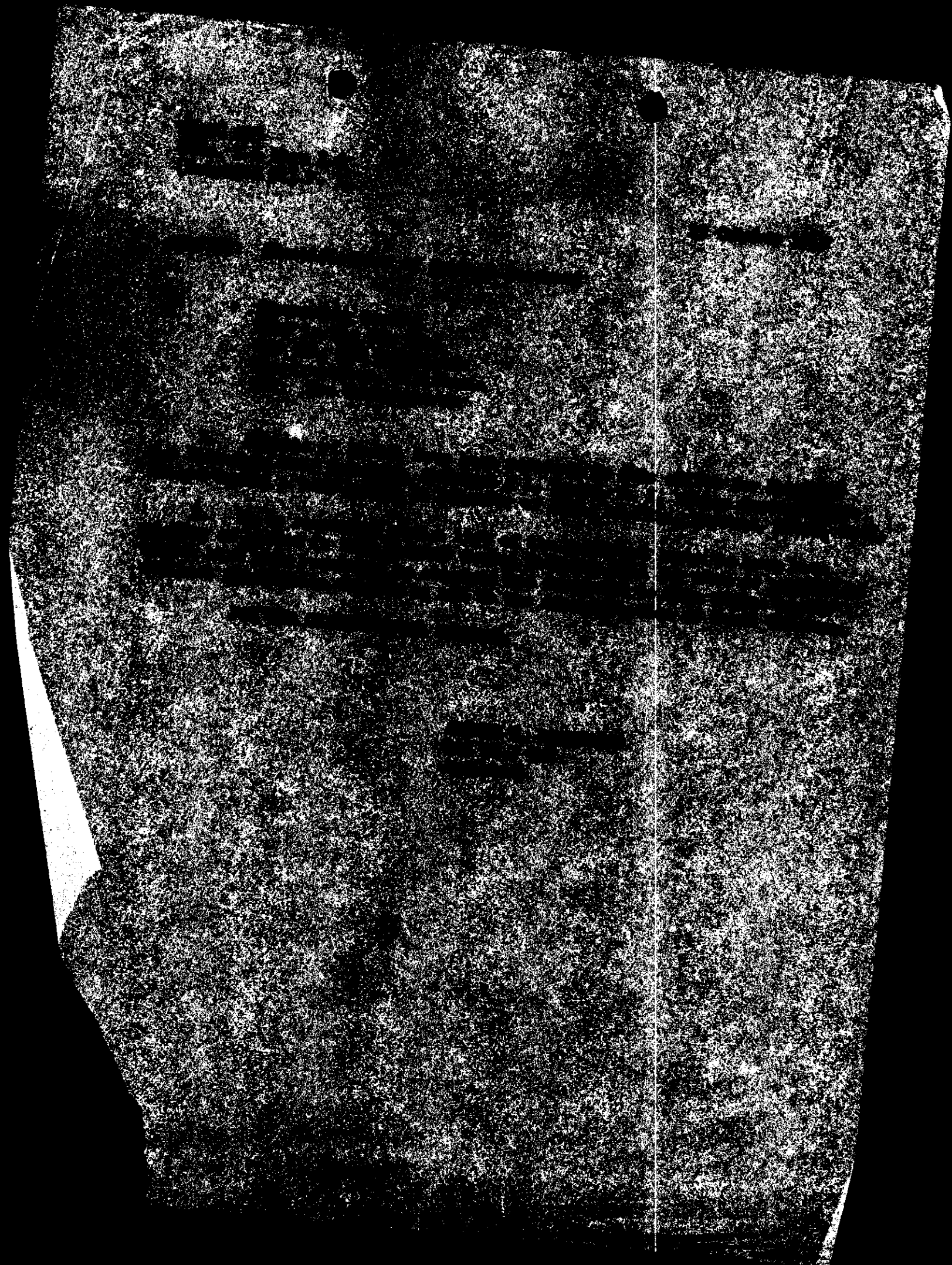

SUBJECT: Report on Isolated Burials.

TO : Chief Quartermaster, AFWESPAC, APO 707.

1. Reference is made to Letter, Headquarters, 1st Cavalry Division, Office of Commanding General, APO 261, dated 1 June, 1945, Subject; Investigation of Graves and Burial Plots included as Inclosure No.1.
2. On 5 July, 1945, Captain Duennebier and 1st Sgt. Warfield, Graves Registration Service of Base "R" visited the barrie of Pils for the purpose of recovering the isolated burial. Nicholas Ebariada-dalasa could not be contacted but two civilians who helped inter the body were located and they led us to the grave site. The remains were disinterred from a shallow grave and although a careful search was made, no identification tags could be found. Both civilians were questioned but they could not remember burying any tags with the body. The remains were designated as Unknown X-6 and were buried in USAP Cemetery No. 1, Batangas, Luzon, P.I.
3. Several of the local inhabitants of the barrie were questioned and it was learned that five (5) Americans were killed in that area during a tank battle in December of 1941. The civilians informed us that shortly after the battle two Americans were found in one of the tanks, one lying in the Driver's section and the other in the assistant driver's section. These two sections are entirely separate and distinct. At the time no effort was made to inter the bodies but dirt was thrown into the tank to cover them. Both sections were examined carefully and parts of the skeletons were found in each. The remains were designated as Unknowns X-7 and X-8 and interred in USAP Cemetery No. 1, Batangas, Luzon, P.I.
4. Although a thorough search was made for the remains of the other two Americans, nothing could be found. We were informed that formerly the tank was on the edge of a bank, one body lying directly below it in a rice paddy and the other inside. No effort was made to inter these bodies and at some later date, the Japs rolled the tank over the bank into the rice paddy. The inhabitants stated that dogs and other animals were seen carrying bones and that there was little left of the bodies. This was quite evident in every case because in the three Unknowns which were disinterred, many parts of the skeletons were missing and the bodies were buried under such circumstance that made them easily accessible to animals.

5. The entire investigation resulted in the fact that the remains of three Americans (all Unknowns) were recovered out of the five who were killed in that area. Information obtained from the inhabitants of that locality establish beyond a doubt that three were three distinct bodies which were disinterred and that there were two others which could not be recovered.


