After an extensive study of these cases, it is considered that the evidence presented cannot be interpreted as sufficient for individual identification.

The association of these four decedents with the remains recovered from the communal grave, Cabanatuan A & Cemetery, is based on information contained in the Cahanatuan R W Beath Report. Experience with this report has proved it to be a valuable aid for this association of decedents with Unknown remains. However, in repeated instances, it has been shown that the report does not constitute substantive proof within itself. Therefore, it is subject to qualifying or appetantiating comparison of dental and physical data.

To Engineel and dental records for the decedents involved in these came are probably incomplete. They represent a marked similarity will would probably compare equally well with any crosssection of remains recovered from Cabanatuan Cemetery.

ince there is no adequate substantiating evidence available in the case, Board Proceedings have been disapproved and are herewith.


