1. In accordance with the provisions of your letter, file QMGMU 293, GRS (Far East), dated 17 September 1948, subject: Resolution of Cases of Unidentified Deceased, the remains of UNKNOWN X-4531, AGRS Mausoleum, Manila P.I., (originally disinterred from Grave 854, Cabanatuan POW Cemetery) were processed by the Central Identification Laboratory and considered "Unidentifiable" by reason of lack of sufficient identifying data.

2. Above listed Unknown could not be definitely associated with any of the Cabanatuan POW decedents due to insufficiency of positive identification factors.

3. Forwarded herewith, for your consideration, are new QMC Forms 1044 for the above mentioned Unknown.

4. Also submitted herewith is a list showing the status of the Unknown recovered from afore-mentioned grave.

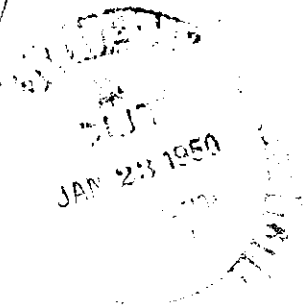
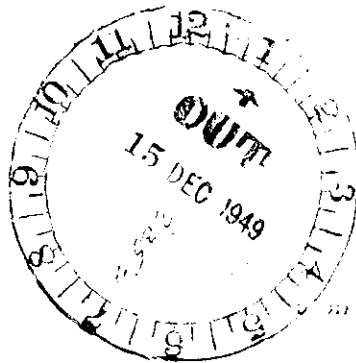

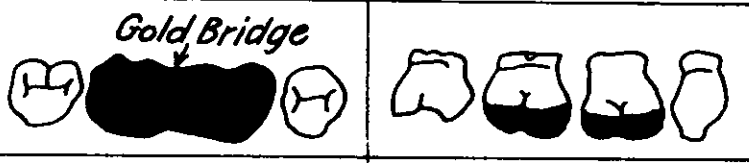
