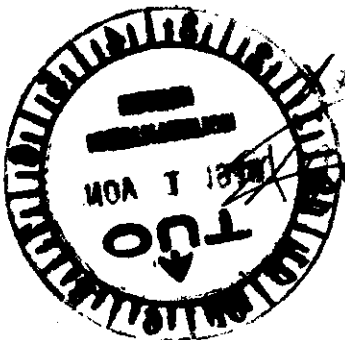

1. Reference is made to Proceedings of your Board of Review, dated 12 August 1948 and 21 October 1948, recommending individual identifications as follows:

Unknown X-4888 AONE Honolulu Hawaii, P.I., as Pfc Bernard F. Sweet, 8 977 833.

Remains identified as Pvt. William E. Brown, 14 G10 527, be re-identified as Pvt. Henry D. Gardner, 39 G01 669.

2. After an extensive study of these cases, it is considered that the evidence presented cannot be interpreted as sufficient for individual identification.

3. The Army dental records for Pfc. Sweet at date of enlistment, 1 August 1940, show no teeth missing and no teeth filled. The next of kin for Pfc. Sweet states that prior to his entry in the Army, he had no dental work accomplished. The dental chart for the remains of Unknown X-4888 shows restorations for which no comparison is possible, due to the incompleteness of the dental information for Pfc. Sweet. Therefore, the comparison is inconclusive and does not present adequate identifying data for possible association for Pfc. Sweet with the remains of Unknown X-4888.

4. The original dental records accomplished for the remains interred as Pvt. William E. Brown, 14 G10 527, compare favorably with the Army dental records noted for Pfc. Brown upon enlistment in July 1940. The later dental chart accomplished for these remains is not discrepant inasmuch as the decedent could have had dental work accomplished in the period of the two years preceding his death in October 1942.

5. The association of these decedents with the remains is based upon information contained in the Oahu Army PGW Death Report. Experience with this report has proved it to be a valuable aid for the

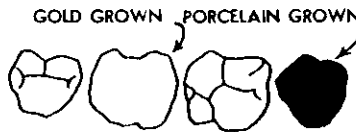

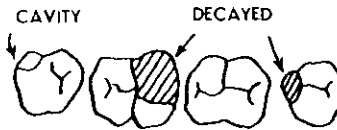
