1. Reference is made to Case History for Remains Considered Identifiable, dated 19 January 1949, your headquarters, recommending the following identification:

X-4682, AGNS Hanoi, Manila (Formerly X-644, USAF Cemetery Manila #2) as: 1/Lt Ralph E. Bennett, O-106 696

2. After a thorough analysis of this case, it has been considered that identifying information is insufficient for identification. Records of the Department of the Army indicate no defects in dental data for Lt. Bennett, and that he sustained fractures of the right shoulder, foot and first finger prior to his enlistment. A re-examination of the remains of Unknown X-4682 failed to substantiate these records.

3. It is therefore recommended that consideration be given to the above information relative to possible findings of unidentifiability for the remains of Unknown X-4682 and possible findings of Non-Recoverability for Lt. Bennett.

Case History for Remains Considered Identifiable, dated 19 January 1949, recommending the following identification ;

X-4682, AGRS Mausoleum, Manila (Formerly X-644, USAF Cemetery Manila # 2)
as 1/Lt. Ralph E. Bennett, O-396 696

has been processed tentatively by the investigator with unfavorable results.

It is believed that the evidence presented by the Field is insufficient to establish identification for the following reasons :

- 1- Available Army Dental Records for Lt. Bennett do not compare with the dental chart accomplished for the remains of Unknown X-4682. (St. Louis and NOK have been contacted for additional dental data with negative results)
- 2- Army Records indicate that Lt. Bennett sustained the following fractures during 1939 and 1940 :
 - a - Fractured right foot
 - b - Fractured right first finger
 - c - Fractured right shoulder

The Field has indicated that the remains of Unknown X-4682 were re-examined for evidence of old fractures with negative results.

It is therefore recommended that the Field be advised as to disapproval of the Case History and request that the case be reprocessed in accordance with letter QMGMU-293, Far East, dated 17 September 1948, Subject : Resolution of Cases of Unidentified Deceased.

BASIS FOR DECLARING REMAINS IDENTIFIABLE

1. Time, and place of death for UNKNOWN X-4682, shown on ROI and ROS are in agreement with those of 1st Lt. Ralph E. Bennett, shown on his OCMG Form 371 (See Incls. 1, 2, 5, 6, 7 and 8).
2. Affidavit of Capt. Robert E. Conn, Jr., attested by Major Peter Koster, states that 1st Lt. Ralph E. Bennett died at the Hospital No. 2, Bataan, Luzon, P.I. He was listed as "BENNETT Ralph E", an American soldier with rank of 1st Lt. He was also listed on two separated death Registers with the same name and rank, 71st Inf., Philippine Army, however organization is not stated on affidavit. Serial number on affidavit and on the separated Registers was not stated. (See Incl. 8).
3. ROS for UNKNOWN X-4682, lists the UNKNOWN as BTB BENNETT, Ralph E.
4. Remains of UNKNOWN X-4682, were recovered in an isolated burial in Bataan, Hospital Cemetery No. 2, Bataan, Luzon, P.I. Grave No. 66. (See Incl. 6)
5. Rank, organization and branch of service for UNKNOWN X-4682 shown on ROI and ROS are in agreement with those of 1st Lt. Ralph E. Bennett shown on his OCMG Form 371 (See Incls., 1, 2, 5, 6, 7 and 8).
6. Estimated height of UNKNOWN X-4682 shown on OCMG Form 1044 is in agreement with that shown on OCMG Form 371 for 1st Lt. Ralph E. Bennett. (See Incls. 1 and 3).
7. Dental chart for UNKNOWN X-4682 indicated on OCMG Form 1044a compares very favorably with that of 1st Lt. Ralph E. Bennett indicated on his OCMG Form 371 (See Incls. 1 and 4).
8. OCMG Form 371 for 1st Lt. BENNETT was compared with identification data for all the other UNKNOWNs recovered from that area, with negative results.

The dental chart of UNKNOWN X-4682 compares very favorably with dental chart of 1st Lt. Bennett, based on the following comparison.

Both chart's indicates all teeth present or having been present at time of death.

Amalgam fillings for R-8, 7, 6, 14 and L-6, 7, 16 were probably made after dental chart of 1st Bennett was accomplished, 7 March 1941.

R-16 and L-15 probably become carious after dental chart of 1st Lt. Bennett was made.

R-3 thru L-2, L-5, L-8, R-13 and R-10 thru L-9 posthomously lost.



S T A T E M E N T

Remains designated Unknown X-4682, formerly X-644, Manila No. 2, were rechecked for possible old fractures of the right foot, right 1st finger and right shoulder.

Head of right humerus, right clavicle and right scapula were checked for possible calcification to indicate an old healed fracture but the findings were negative. The scapula was in advanced stage of decomposition but the portion present with remains appears normal. The right clavicle is partially decomposed on the acromial and sternal ends. The body of the clavicle is intact and shows no evidence of an old healed fracture. The phalanges of the right hand and right foot did not indicate a former fracture, however, not all of the finger^{foot} or bones were present with remains.

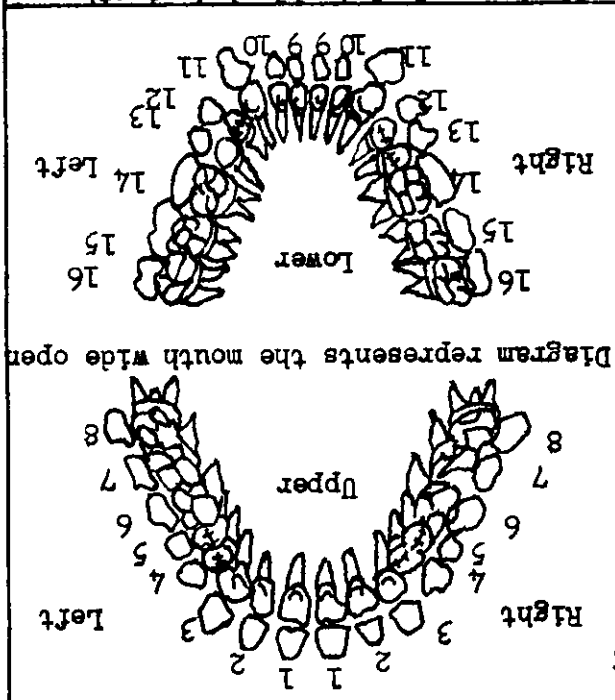

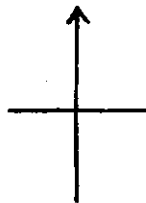
