REMARKS

Field Board Proceedings have been received recommending the identification of the remains of Unknown X-4791-A as Pfc. Raymond Trujillo, 6 953 585.

Records indicate that Pfc. Raymond Trujillo, 6 953 585, died 30 May 1942, while a prisoner of war at Camp O'Donnell, POW Camp, Luzon, P.I., of malaria and psychosis. According to the Camp O'Donnell roster, remains, later designated as Unknown X-645 USAF Cemetery Manila #2, were believed to be those of "Raymond, T."

Unknown X-645 was recovered at Camp O'Donnell, POW Camp, Luzon, P.I., in plot G, row 9, grave 5. A search of the records reveals no casualty in the Philippine Zone by the name of "Raymond, T." In processing Unknown X-645 at CIP Laboratory, Manila, the remains of two bodies were found and segregated according to their bone structure and designated as Unknowns X-4791-A and B. Unknown X-4791-B is being recommended for still number.

Due to a discrepancy in the plot, row, and grave number located on the casualty report for Pfc. Trujillo and original ROI for Unknown X-4314-A and B (Formerly Unknown A-1330, believed to be R. Trujillo), identification data for these Unknowns were checked with negative results.

ASN o 958 056 found on storage reports for Unknown X-4791-A and B (believed to be Raymond, T.) is an error inasmuch as this serial number is assigned to James P. Flynn, for whom AG Casualty branch has no record of casualty. However, this serial number is an approximation of the serial number for Pfc. Trujillo. The name and initial "Raymond, T." are in agreement with the first name and first letter of the last name of Pfc. Raymond Trujillo.

The dental chart and estimated height for Unknown X-4791-A compares favorably with the dental chart and reported height for Pfc. Raymond Trujillo, 6 953 585.

On the basis of the findings from the Field as explained herein, it is recommended that the identification of the remains of Unknown X-4791-A as proposed by the Field, be approved.

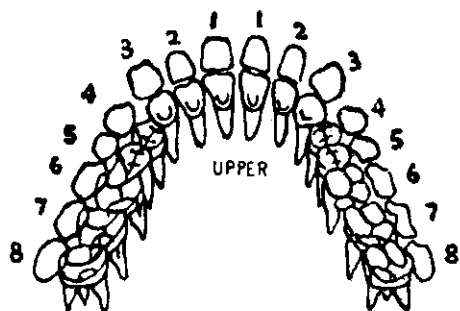
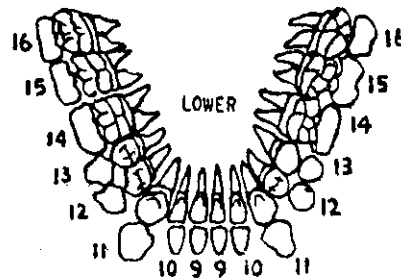
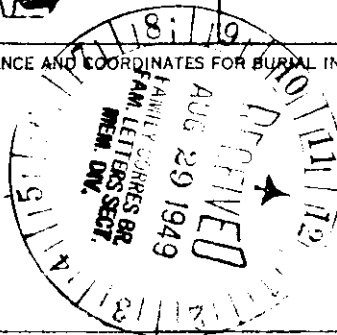


DIAGRAM REPRESENTS THE MOUTH WIDE OPEN
