Field Board Proceedings have been received recommending the identification of the remains of Unknown X-4791-A as Pfc. Raymond Trujillo, 6 953 585.

decords indicate that rfc. Asymond Trujillo, 6 953 585, died 30 May 1942, while a prisoner of war at Camp O'Donnell, FOW Camp, Luzon, F.I., of malaria and psychosis. According to the Camp O'Donnell roster, remains, later designated as Jilmown A-645 UpaF Semetery Familia  $_{HZ}$ , were believed to be those of "maymend, T."

Unknown X-045 was recovered at Camp C'Dennell, row Camp, Luzon, F.I., in plot G, row 9, grave 5. A search of the records reveals no casualty in the Philippine Zone by the name of " maxword, T." In processing Unknown X-045 at the Laboratory, Lamila, the remains of two podies were found and segregated according to their pone structure and designated as Unknowns X-4791-A and B. Unknown X-4791-b is being recommended for XI number.

Due to a discrepancy in the plot, row, and grave number located on the Casualty report for lfc. Trujille and original nOl for Unknown A-4014-A and B (Formerly Unknown A-1636, believed to be m. Frujillo), identification data for these Unknowns were checked with negative results.

ASN o 958 056 found on storage reports for Unknown X-4791-A and B (beleived to be maymond, T.) is an error inasmuch as this serial number is assigned to James P. Flynn, for which AG Casualty branch has no record of casualty. However, this serial number is an approximation of the serial number for Pfc. Trujillo. The name and initial "Maymond, T." are in agreement with the first name and first letter of the last name of Pfc. Maymond frujillo.

The dental chart and estimated height for Unknown X-4791-A compares favorably with the dental chart and reported height for Mg. naymond Trujillo, 6 953 585.

On the basis of the findings from the Field as explained herein, it is recommended that the identification of the remains of Unknown n-1/791-n as proposed by the Field, be approved.
