As requested, the above eight (8) remains were examined by me for fractures of wrists, and noses, and amputations of toes.

The facial portions of the crania of all but UNK 1-675 are missing precluding an examination for broken noses. The portions of the nasal bones present of UNK 1-675 do not indicate that they have been broken.

The wrist and toe bones of the eight (8) remains are largely missing, or so eroded, that no accurate determination of fractures of the wrists or amputation of the toes was possible.
