2. Board Proceedings are returned herewith disapproved for the following reasons:

a. Army dental records for Opl Wells indicate that he had restorations in teeth L-1, L-2, and L-4. Dental charts for X-3523 indicate these teeth present and in perfect condition. A revised QMC Form 371 for Opl Wells showing the above restorations was forwarded to your headquarters on 16 June 1949.

b. It has been determined that the dental and physical comparisons between records for Pfc Bassett and records for X-3525 are not sufficiently conclusive to prove this recommendation beyond all doubt.

1. Board Proceedings, your headquarters, dated 11 April 1949, Subject; Case History For Remains Considered Identifiable As A Group, recommending that Unknowns X-3523, X-3524, X-3525, AGRS Mausoleum, Manila be identified as the remains of Cpl. William J. Wells, ASN 36204774, PFC Harvey A. Bassett, ASN 19021117, and Mr. Thomas Lovett, US Army Civilian Employee, are returned herewith disapproved.

2. A comparison of Army and civilian dental records for the subject decedents with the dental charts prepared for the subject Unknowns indicates that the Unknowns are not the remains of the decedents. The recorded height for PFC Bassett is indicated to be 60½ inches, while the estimated height for the three Unknowns exceeds that figure by at least 7 inches, indicating that the remains of PFC Bassett could not be represented in the group. The dental record for Mr. Lovett indicates that he had two gold restorations, yet not one of the three Unknowns presents dental features with gold restorations. The dental records for Cpl. Wells present characteristics which cannot be associated with any one of the remains, indicating that his remains are not represented in the group.

3. Inclosed are OQM Forms 371 for the subject decedents reflecting additional dental information.
