1. Reference is made to Proceedings of your soard of Review. dated 20 July 1949, recommending the following identification:

> Unknown X-4721, AGRS Mansoleum, Manila, P. I. (formerly Unknown X-775, USAF Cemetery, Manila #2) as Pvt. Angelus E. Vise, 16 008 654.

- 2. After a thorough analysis of this case, it has been determined that the evidence presented is not sufficient to establish identification. The remains of Unknown X-4721 were disinterred from Plot F. Row 6. Grave 6. Camp O'Donnell Cemetery. There is me evidence indicating the grave location of Pvt. Wise. The dental and physical comparisons do not afford positive individual identification.
- 3. Board Proceedings have been disapproved for the reasons outlined above and are returned herewith.

DISAPPROVAL OF BOARD FINDINGS

Recommended for identification on Board Proceedings dated 8 July 1949, as the remains of:

WISE, Angelus E. Pvt. 16 008 654

I. Reasons for Disapproval

The remains of Unknown X-4721 were originally interred in the American POW Cemetery, Camp O'Dennell, Plot F, Rew 6, Grave 6 en-16 May 1942.

Records of the AGO indicate that Pvt. Wise died in the O'Donnell POW Camp 10 May 1942. The death rester for Camp O'Donnell does not list Pvt.


<u>Angelus</u> E. Wise, however, Pvt. <u>Angus</u> Wise is listed as having died in May 1942, with no indication of grave location.

The dental chart accomplished for Unknown X-4721 compares favorably with Army dental records for Pvt. Wise insofar as extractions are concerned, however, the comparison is not conclusive for positive identification.

II. Recommended Action

Beard Proceedings be disapproved.


