





- 1. Deceased is edg of the fear remains disinterred from a common grave 1/2 klasseter porthers of a Filipino POW Cometery in the Camp O'Donnell Park, inclusive Area, Luzon, P. I. (See attached sketch)
- 2. Remains could not be identified although search of remnants of clothing and personal effects found in grave were carefully searched for slues. Matives in the vicinity could give no assistance as to identity.
- Personal effects found in this common grave could not be associated with any past commiss and consist of the following articles:
  - 1. Chronometer nickel plated, no markings or serial numbers.
  - 2. Plastic ring colorlags, no initial, appears to be home made.
  - 3. Two insignia one Filipino, one unidentified.
  - 4. Remains of wwilp of paper, believed to be remains of a special order not legible.
  - 5. Three coins, (Two 1 centavo and one 5 centavo)
- 4. These four deceased taken from the common graves are burled in USAF Cemetery Manila #2. Luson, P. I. as follows:
