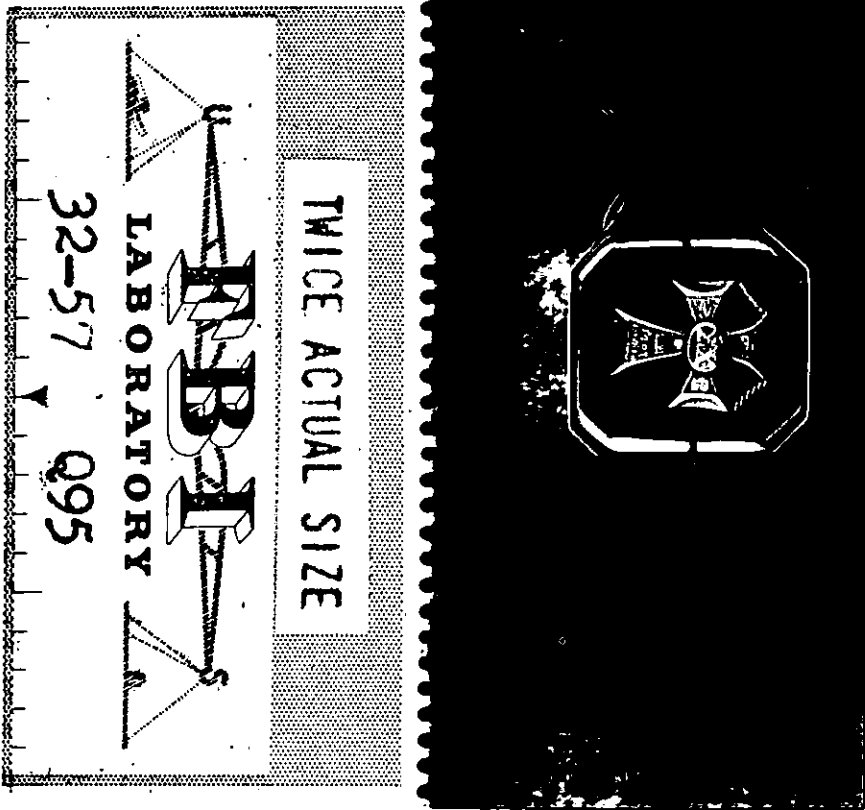
SKELETAL CHART X-661
