1. Reference is made to Case History dated 2 August 1950, PHILCOB ZONE, recommending that the remains of Unknowns X-702, X-708, X-712, X-713, X-714, X-719 and X-720, AGRA Mausoleum, Manila, P. I., be identified as the recoverable remains of the below listed unaccounted for USS CRUSTES casualties:

2. The recommendation of the Board is disapproved.

3. Recent reprocessing of USS CRUSTES casualties reveals that PRUDENFELD, Monte N. S1c 9619071 USNR and SMITH, John C., Jr., S1c 9362039 USNR, both of whom were attached to Motor Torpedo Boat Squadron 25, were missing in action and determined dead as a result of the attack on the USS CRUSTES.

4. It is noted that the dental characteristics of X-708 are similar to those of SMITH and the dental comparison of X-712 with PRUDENFELD is favorable, however it is noted that no articulation

exists between the skull and vertebrae for X-708. The original Report of Interment for X-708 which was designated Unknown X-4 USAF Cemetery San Jose #1, Mindoro, P. I. indicates the height of the deceased was 5'11", weight 170#. This report further stated that death resulted from shrapnel wounds of the head. The latest reprocessing report does not reflect a skull injury.

5. In view of the above facts it is requested the Unknown remains X-708 and X-712 be reprocessed with a view toward individual identification of FRIEDENFELD and SMITH. OMM Form 371 and Navied Form H-4 are inclosed for your information.

6. If the individual identification of X-708 and X-712 can be effected, further consideration of a group identification which would contain five (5) remains and the fifteen (15) referenced casualties is not defensible in view of the lack of identification media and also the absence of documentary information which would associate these unknown remains with USS CRISTY casualties.

7. It is further requested that the unaccounted for casualties from the USS CRISTY be processed in accordance with paragraph 59h, SR-830-110-5 dated 3 March 1949.
