



I found an insignia A, of an eagle, but I gave the insignia to an American when they arrived in this place recently. N - Where did you pick up the man? - I found him three (3) meters from this spot; he A was already dead. Probably he died of hunger. - About how old was the man? N - About 50 or 55 years old. A - Did you get anything that was on the body of the N man? - I got only the eagle, which was like silver. A - Did you find any identification on the body? N A - I also found a suitcase. N - Where is the suitcase? - I threw it away because I was scared of the Japanese; they kill as the never they see something belonging to Americans in our possession. - Where did you throw the suitcase? N - I do not remember now; it had been a long time ago so I cannot remember. - Did you find a dog tag on the man? (Showed him N what a dog tag is) - I found something like that around the neck of the A man, but I threw it away. I was scared of the Japanese. - Where did you throw that tag? N A - You cannot find it anymore, it had been a long time since. - Do you remember the name written on the dog tag? Ν - No sir, I do not know how to read and nobody saw A the tag. I threw it away in 1942. - Can you describe the appearance of the man you N buried here? - He is tall, about 6 feet, and weighing about 190 lbs. - What color was his hair? N

NIEVES - Did he have any gold teeth?

A - No sir. One of his teeth was gone because I hit it with my spade while I was digging this grave.

- Was he dressed up when you buried him?

Yes sir, he was dressed up in khaki uniform.

N - Where did you find the eagle insignia?

A - I got it from the hat of the man.

N - When did you give the insignia to the American?
- When they came here recently. He was a private.

N - Do you think the body is still here.

I cannot tell, but most probably it is still here because I covered it when I buried it here.

Mr. Almario also showed the party a water tank about ten meters from the first spot. The place was enclosed with a cement wall about 3 feet square and two feet high. He said 6 men were buried in that place, one of whom was an American.

N - Did you find any dog tag on the bodies you buried here?

A - Yes sir, Gregorio Asiao found a dog tag here.
(Gregorio Asiao gave use the dog tag with the name
JAMES O. WARD. USA 6282107)

Mr. Asiao testified that the dog tag was found about 7 meters away from the above-mentioned water tank.
