SKELETAL CHART





 - On the basis of the details related in the above paragraphs i seems possible that the above-mentioned grave might contain a total of some nineteen bodies.
- According to the Report of Interment of Wendell F. SWANSON, only fifteen bodies were recovered from this grave.
- Therefore, on 13 September 1946, this grave was reopened by a gravedigging detail under the supervision of a Master Sergeant from the Graves Recovery Team Field Headquarters at 5. Bacolor, Pampanga, and this officer.
