The above nine (9) remains from Graves 825 and 829 Cabanatuan POW Cemetery were reprocessed by me this date for proper segregation, and new QMC Forms 1044 were accomplished for each.

Each of the remains is now properly segregated, and each represents one and the same individual. Improperly segregated bones, which could not be reassociated due to their eroded condition, were assigned OIL #589.

Examination of the three (3) remains from Grave #825 yielded the following associations:

UNK X-4237 Malm. compares very favorably with LeCROY, Douglas W., as to height and absence of extractions. LeCROY's age is not known at this headquarters but the estimate age of the remains is 22 to 28 years.

UNK X-4238 Malm. compares very favorably with SURBER, Donald H., as to short height (SURBER was the shortest decedent involved, and this remains is the shortest of the group), hair color, and absence of extractions and fillings. The third molars marked 'X' on SURBER's dental chart were possibly unerupted at time that the dental chart was made. SURBER's age is not known at this headquarters, but the estimate age of the remains is 22 to 27 years.

UNK X-4239 Malm. compares very favorably with COGGESHALL, Charles A., as to height, race, and absence of extractions and fillings (there was only one (1) small filling on R-14 on this remains). COGGESHALL's age is not known at this headquarters, but the estimate age of the remains is 20 to 25 years.

Examination of the six (6) remains from Grave #829 yielded the following results:

UNK X-4292 Malm. compares perfectly with DANIELS, Elmer as to great height, and pattern of extractions.

UNK X-4233 Malm. compares very favorably with ACCOMANDO, John J., as to height and dental work. The presence of a porcelain (Davis) crown on L-1 is a very diagnostic, and favorable comparison.

UNK X-4236 Malm. compares very favorably with GOURLAY, Carlton R., as to height and pattern of extractions and fillings.

The other three (3) remains from Grave #829 do not compare favorably enough for individual comparison with the other associated descendants.

I recommend the individual identification of the following unknown remains:

3. It is requested that the remains of Unknown X-4232, recommended for identification as Private Elmer Daniels, be reprocessed to determine if teeth I-2 and I-6 were missing before or after death.

4. Additional dental information has been received for Staff Sergeant John J. Accomando, which indicates that he may be associated with Unknown X-4233. A closer dental and height comparison exists between this soldier and the remains of Unknown X-4233, than for the remains of X-4236, recommended for individual identification as this soldier.

5. Dental information for Pfcg Norman W. Finton does not compare favorable with the dental data for the Remains of Unknown X-4237, recommended for identification as this soldier.

6. The comparison of dental data for Unknown X-4238 and Private Donald H. Surber, recommended for individual identification, is not conclusive. This soldier was reported to be buried in Grave 828, and remains were recovered from Grave 825. (See paragraph 2, above). The same situation exists in the case of remains of Unknown X-4239 and Sergeant Charles A. Coggeshall for whom no conclusive dental comparisons are noted.

7. It is requested that remains recovered from Graves 825 and 829, Cabanatuan POW Cemetery, which were recommended for identification be reprocessed in the Central Identification Laboratory, and that finding be reported to the Field Board of Review for their action.
