REMARKS

Case Unknown X-7214 had been previously buried as a single case, but upon processing at Central Identification Point Strasbourg, remains of two (2) men were found and segregation into Unknown X-7214-A and Unknown X-7214-B could be made, because of the difference of size in the bones.

One (1) Identification tag inscribed: EDWARD H. McGRATH - 31325514 was found in P.E. bag with teeth among remains. This identification tag has been forwarded to Hq. AGRC for disposition.

A Tooth Chart has been made out of teeth found and is attached to case Unknown X-7214-A. The teeth and the clothing found are with case Unknown X-7214-A.

Personal Effects found may belong to either of the two cases.

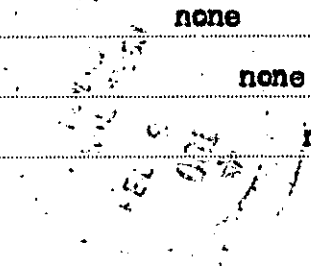

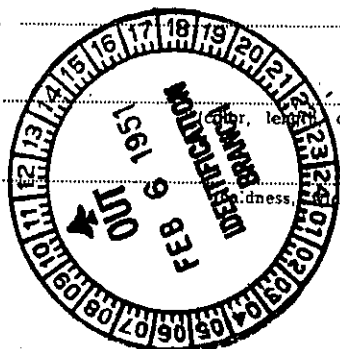

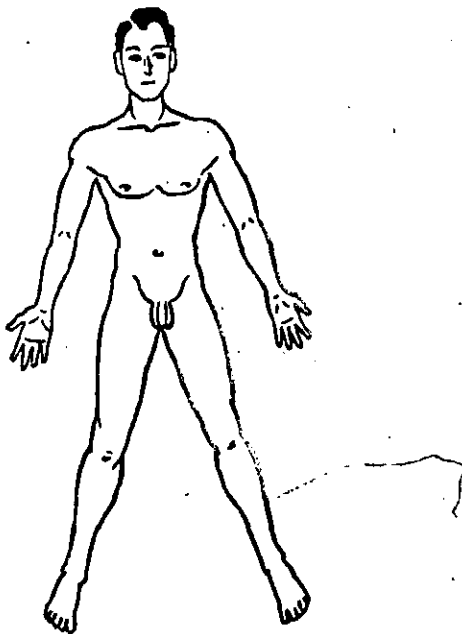

12. Remarks: Case Unknown X-7214 was previously buried as a single case, but upon reprocessing by CIP found to be a mass burial of two men. Segregation was possible into Unk. X-7214 A and Unk. X-7214 B. One left ulna and radial are only two whole bones that case "X-7214 B" consists of. (See anatomical chart) While it is not likely that teeth could belong to this case, they have been charted and placed with case "X-7214 A". Est. weight of processed remains 3 lbs. Fluoroscopic Examination unnecessary. Nothing found to warrant Chemical Laboratory Examination. Personal Effects and Identification Tag are with case Unk. X-7214 A.
