The records pertaining to Unknown X-13037, Plot XXX, Row 4, Grave 48, USMC, St. Avold, France have been reviewed in accordance with par 159, SR 830-110-5, DA, dated 3 March 1949, and it is the opinion of the Board of Review, appointed by par 2, SO No. 66, this headquarters, dated 14 June 1950, that sufficient evidence is not available to establish the identity of the deceased concerned, and it is recommended these remains be classified as unidentifiable..

CASE HISTORY


Unknown X-13037

USMC St. Avoird  
Plot XXX, Row 4, Grave 48

The remains of Unknown X-13037 was segregated from the remains of Unknown X-6518 USMC St. Avoird, disinterred from an isolated grave in Hochmutting Civilian Cemetery, Muenchen, Germany (Map Sheet Germany M-49/Y-86).

Unknown X-6518 is being presented to a Board of Officers as the remains of Sgt. Morris D. WOMAN, 37528647. The Area Search Form indicates that Unknown X-6518 was disinterred from the same common grave in which thirty-five (35) other remains were interred.

In view of this and of the fragmentary condition of the remains, Unknown X-13037 cannot be associated with the many casualties that occurred in that area and it is recommended that this case be declared UNIDENTIFIABLE.
