AFTER ACTION REPORT

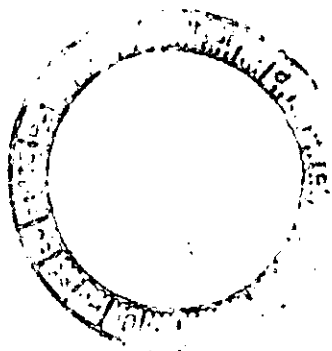
UNITED STATES THIRD ARMY

On 12 December 1944, organizations which were assigned and attached to the 26th Infantry Division, of the III Corps, were occupying positions near the following points:

101st Infantry Regt in the vicinity of METZ  
104th Infantry " " " " " "  
328th Infantry captured high ground south of OBERGAILBACH  
Attached to 26th Div., the 346th Inf (of 87th Inf Div.),  
was at RIMLING  
347th Infantry (87th Inf Div) at assembly area at KULHAUSEN  
south of SARREGUEMINES.  
345th Infantry moved to METZ

Elements of the 35th Infantry Division was able to advance under heavy artillery and small arms fire during this period. The 134th Infantry Regiment of the 35th took HABKIRCHEN, GERMANY and crossed the BLIF RIVER on 12 December 1944 and the 137th Inf (35th Div.) continued to mop up in SARREGUEMINES.

Zones of the 4th and 6th Armored Divisions and the 80th Infantry Divisions were near the Zones of the 26th and 35th Divisions.

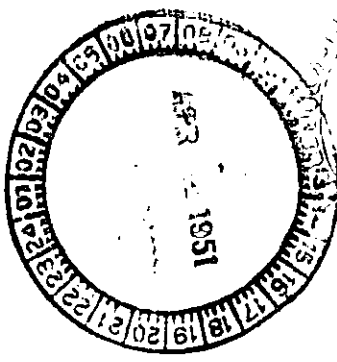

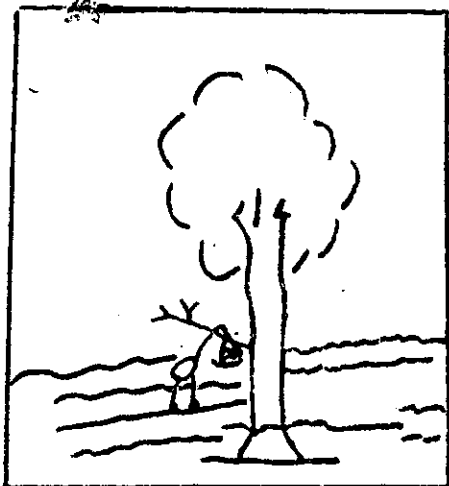
