United States Military Cemetery St Avoird (France)

1. The remains of Unknown X-538, USMC St Avoird, were recovered from the west cemetery at MUNICH, Germany. All efforts to associate this case with any of the unresolved casualties within the Germany M-49 area and other adjoining areas have been unsuccessful.

2. The tooth chart contained in the case on Unknown X-538 was compared with all available dental data on unresolved casualties within the M-49 area and other adjoining areas with negative results.

3. In view of the foregoing and due to a lack of conclusive identifying data, it is recommended that this case be declared UNIDENTIFIABLE.

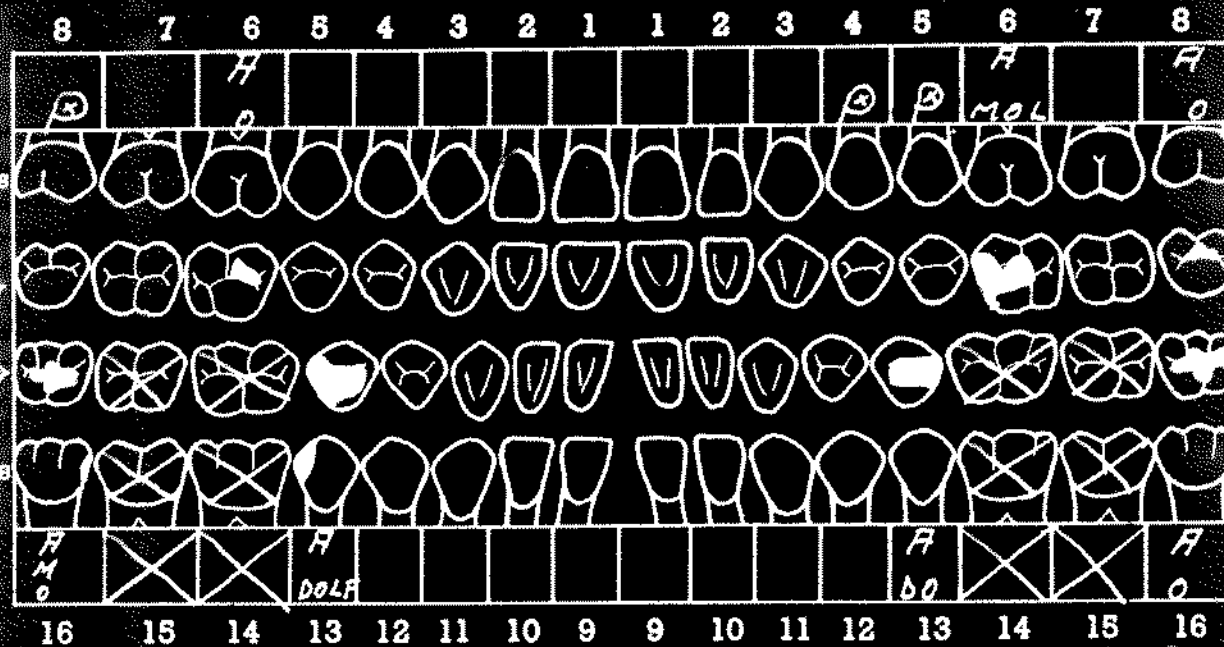

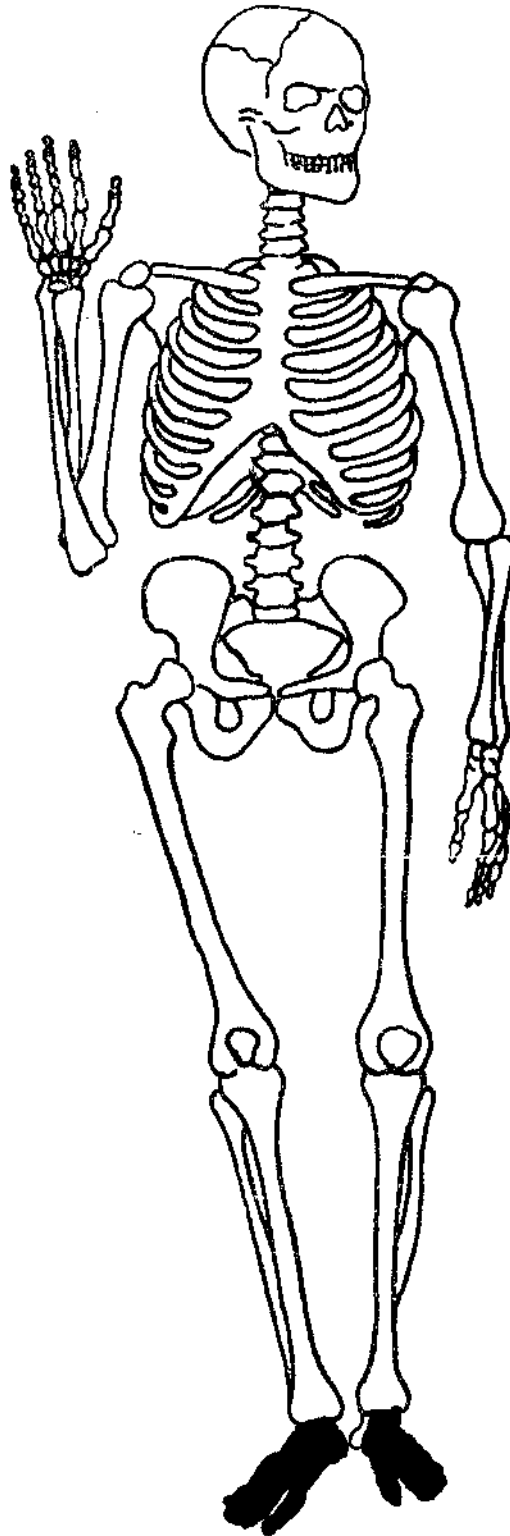
