1. Reference is made to corrected Report of Burial dated 9 September 1947 for S/Sgt. George M. Theobald, 19 010 327, previously X-6315, USMC St. Avold, France, Plot X, Row 1, Grave 11.

2. This identification cannot be presented for approval due to the following discrepancies:

a. Check List dated 13 March 1947 for X-6315 indicates the remains were fully clothed and a 2nd Lt. bar was found on the collar of wool shirt. This information does not agree with rank of S/Sgt. George M. Theobald.

NOTE: The only deceased officer was 2nd Lt. Arthur C. Roth, O-820068, who was identified in Plot BBBB, Row 6, Grave 70 by Identification Tag. These remains were reprocessed on 22 July 1947 and the identification verified by laundry marks found on clothing, however, no indication was made as to whether the remains were fully clothed. It is further noted that tooth chart accomplished for the deceased identified as 2nd Lt. Roth indicates R8 as extracted and R7 with two (2) occlusal amalgam fillings, whereas DIR for 2nd Lt. Roth indicates R8 and R7 as extracted.

b. Clothing sizes found on remains of X-6315 do not correspond with build of S/Sgt. Theobald whose records indicate his height as 65½" and weight as 121 lbs.

LETTER OF INSTRUCTIONS TO EXHUMATION ORDER #2162
(OPO & T Division)

1. The remains presently identified as M/Sgt. THEOBALD, previously Unknown X-6315, were recovered from an isolated Grave along with the additional crew members of A/C 42-52679. A review of related records indicates that no additional crews or casualties are involved.

2. The above identification was based on a process of elimination and the fact that a comparison of dental information is not negative. However, the Identification Check List dated 13 March 1947, Unknown X-6315, indicates that remains were received "fully clothed", shirt, wool OD, remnants of w/AC insignia and 2/Lt. bar found on collar of wool shirt.

3. The original Report of Interment dated 19 June 1946, Unknown X-6315, states that no personal effects were recovered and only remnants of a "shirt khaki" were present.

4. The only officer crew member, 2nd Lt. ROTH, according to available records, was wearing "suntans". The identification of Lt. Roth was verified on 22 July 1947 upon reprocessing through laundry marks found on clothing and identification tags.

5. A comparison of evident physical characteristics of Unknown X-6315 and M/Sgt. Theobald is negative and not favorable compared with 2nd Lt. Roth.

6. In view of the above, it is believed that a transposition of remains occurred at the time of original interment involving Unknown X-6315 and another deceased, designation unknown.

7. It is requested that an investigation be conducted to resolve the above discrepancies and to determine the second remains involved in the transposition.

8. Should your investigation meet with negative results, the remains of Unknown X-6315 will be processed by an accredited anthropologist to accomplish an accurate height estimate.

9. Due to an OCMG inquiry, it is requested that results of your investigation be furnished this Headquarters at the earliest practicable date.

10. OCMG Forms 371 for Lt. Roth and M/Sgt. Theobald are inclosed as an aid in processing.
