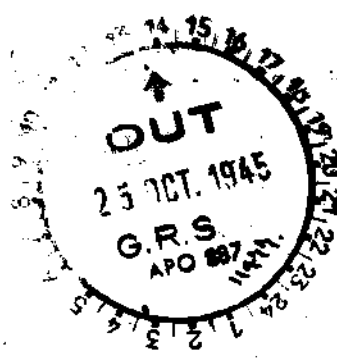

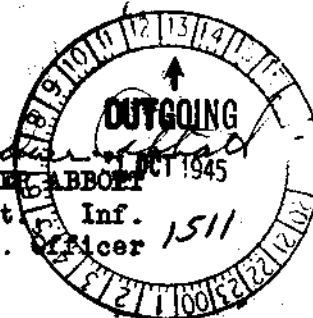

CERTIFICATE OF UNIDENTIFIABILITY OF REMAINS

1. The records pertaining to Unknown X-8136, Plot FF, Row 3, Grave 35, USMC, St. Auld, France. have been reviewed in accordance with par 159, SR 830-110-5, DA, dated 3 March 1949, and it is the opinion of the Board of Review, appointed by par 2, SO No. 66, this headquarters, dated 14 June 1950, that sufficient evidence is not available to establish the identity of the deceased concerned, and it is recommended these remains be classified as unidentifiable.

Case History

Unknown X-8136

USMC St. Avel, France
Plot 77, Row 3, Grave 36

The remains of Unknown X-8136, USMC St. Avel, France, were recovered from an isolated grave at BARANTHAL, Moselle, France.

These remains were formerly identified as those of Cpl. Thomas J. Morlock, 32580211, by an identification tag bearing his name, but upon reprocessing, Unknown X-534 USMC St. Avel was definitely identified as the remains of Cpl. MORLOCK.

The tooth chart for Unknown X-8136 has been checked against all available dental records of unresolved casualties on Moselle Map Sheet with negative results; particular attention was given to the vicinity of Barenthal.

A thorough investigation has been conducted in an effort to associate these remains by other means with all available information in this headquarters but no association could be made.

In view of the negative results of the investigation, it is recommended that this case be declared UNIDENTIFIABLE.
