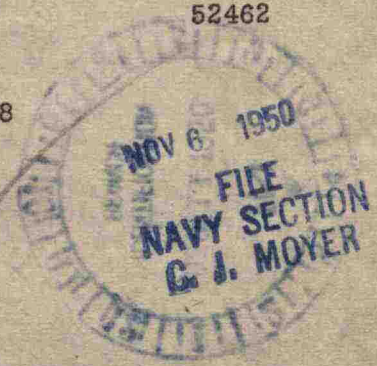

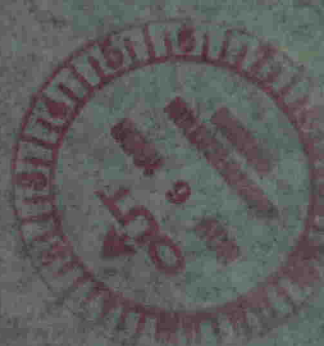

The Certificate of Unidentifiability dated 28 March 1950 from PhilCom Zone for Unknown remains X-38, 2nd Marine Division Cemetery, Saipan, indicates these remains were disinterred from Plot C, Row 9, Grave 10. A certified true copy of Report of Disinterment for X-38 dated 30 June 1948 is also referred to.

A report of Interment dated 1 June 1946 for Pfc Dwain A. WRIGHT, 830313, USMC in the 293 file of Wright indicates a burial location of Plot C, Row 9, Grave 10.

PFC WRIGHT was originally reported interred in Plot C, Row 8, Grave 6, 2nd Marine Division Cemetery, Saipan. The next of kin was notified of this location.

Upon disinterment of the 2nd Marine Division Cemetery, Saipan in June 1946, Plot C, Row 8, Grave 6 was found to be vacant, however, the remains of Wright were found to be in Plot C, Row 9, Grave 10.

As a result of the notification of the next of kin, the remains of Wright were moved from Plot C, Row 9, Grave 10 into Plot C, Row 8, Grave 6 to conform with the records.

The remains of WRIGHT were subsequently returned to the US for permanent burial.

The origin of Unknown remains X-38 was questioned by letter from this Office QMGMN 293 Unknown X-38, 2nd Marine Division Cemetery, Saipan dated August 22, 1950, subject: Request for Report of Burial. The 1st Indorsement to this letter from PhilCom Zone reports that an original Report of Interment for X-38 is not available.
