1. Reference is made to the Report of Storage and previous burial reports for Unknown X-6, AGRS Mausoleum (formerly X-35, Finisch No. 1).

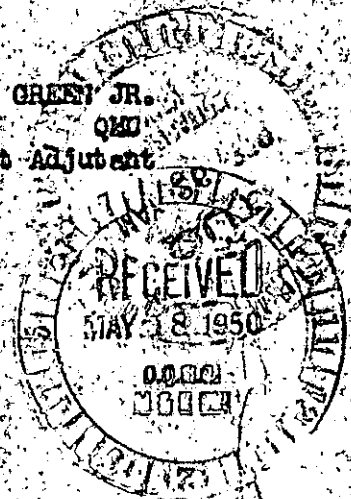



2. It is believed that the pistol in question was issued in the United States as combat crews arriving at that time usually were already equipped with small arms.

3. Attention is invited to Inclosure 1, copy of a Casualty Letter from this organization on 15 June, 1944. It is believed that this information may have a direct bearing in establishing the identity of the deceased person mentioned in Par 2, basic communication.

4. Organizational records of the issue of small arms by the 408th Bombardment Squadron(H), of this Group, were lost during the move to Leyte, P.I. That organization has no means of determining whether pistol #1066555 was issued to Sgt Warren R. Brunn, 36809708, or to any other member of that organization.

The plane was intercepted by five enemy fighters and disabled by machine gun and cannon fire. The pilot crash-landed the plane 16 miles up the coast from Tadji and 1 and 1/2 miles off shore, and soldier was seen in water with life vest inflated, apparently unhurt. Four members of the crew made the shore but soldier was nowhere in sight.
