The People's Committee of Ptuj herewith coertify that an American fighter plane type "Lightning" crashed in July 1944 in a field near the village Cirkovci, county of Ptuj.

According to the evidence given by the civilians, the plane was shot down by a flak from an armoured train at the reilway station Strnesce. The body of the pilot was found nearby with smashed head. He was about 28 years old, a well built man. USA insignie were found on his clothing.

Among the debris of the plane a machine gun International V Harvester # 119527 and aplate on an engine: Signal Corps RACK FT 244-A st. 53893 CNO 11411 WF have been found.

The body was buried in the local cemetery at Cirkovci near Ptuj.




