a. That MACR concerning this case is not available on file in this office.

4. FINDINGS:

a. That an American fighter plane crashed in July 1944 in a field near the village Cirkovci, Ptuj, Yugo. Co-ords: 46°25'N-15°51'E. (See Ex: "A")

b. That the pilot apparently left the plane too late and was found dead with smashed head nearby. (See Ex: "A")

c. That the local civilians identified the plane and the pilot as American. (See Ex: "A")

d. That the body of the pilot was buried in the local cemetery at Cirkovci. (See Ex: "A") ✓

e. That burial was not recorded in the register of death.

f. That 2nd Lt. insignia was found on a piece of clothing found ✓ on remains.

g. That upon exhumation the remains of an American airman were found. Head missing.

h. That the plane was identified by a machine gun International ✓ Harvester # 119527.

i. That individual identification was impossible.

j. That Check list of Unknowns was filled out.



CERTIFICATE

The People's Committee of Ptuj herewith certify that an American fighter plane type "Lightning" crashed in July 1944 in a field near the village Cirkovci, county of Ptuj.

According to the evidence given by the civilians, the plane was shot down by a flak from an armoured train at the railway station Strnesce. The body of the pilot was found nearby with smashed head. He was about 28 years old, a well built man. USA insignia were found on his clothing.

Among the debris of the plane a machine gun International Harvester # 119527 and a plate on an engine: Signal Corps RACK FT 244-A st. 53893 CNO 11411 WF have been found.

The body was buried in the local cemetery at Cirkovci near Ptuj.

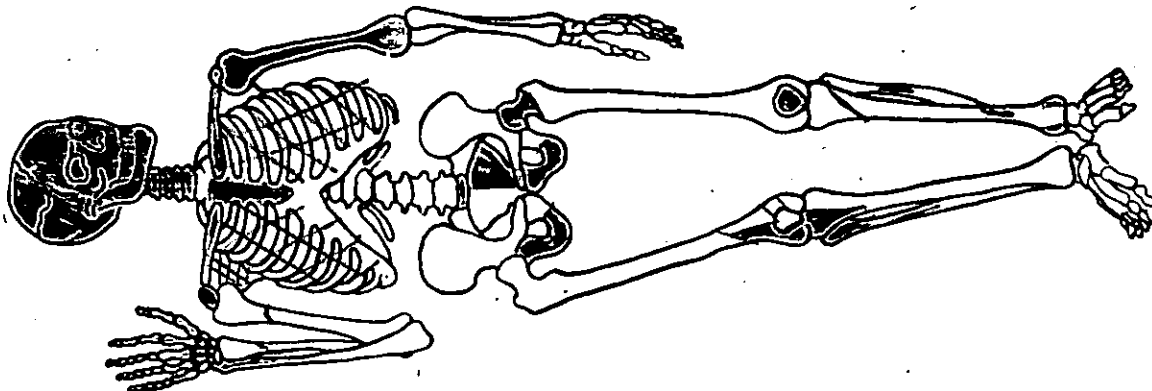

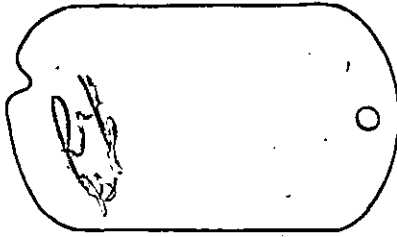

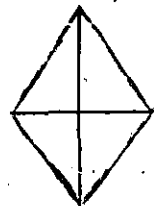
