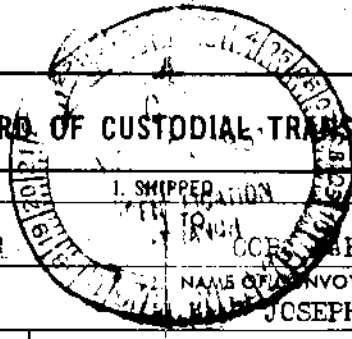

a. That the plane B-24-H AAF Ser. No. 41-28902, piloted by Lt. George T. Conway Jr., was last contacted by radio over Vienna, Austria, as stated by MACR.

c. That statements from the civilians state that all crew members left the plane before it hit the ground, but that the last one to jump was Lt. Conway, whose chute did not have sufficient time to open before he hit the ground.

d. That on the same day the Germans brought the body to the grave keeper at Krapina for burial. At this time the body had some clothing on it. The Germans took all of his identification and clothing from the body, and left it nude for the keeper to bury. (See Ex: "C")

e. That the Germans gave the grave keeper the name of the deceased American as Lt. George T. Conway, O-777598. (See Ex: "C")

f. That the grave keeper declared that on the same day in the morning he buried a German Gestapo agent, who had been caught working for the Croatian Partisans. A bullet hole was found thru his head. He was buried in a coffin.

g. That the keeper was ordered by the Germans to bury the American in the same grave as the German agent, and this he did by placing the American on top of the German, with the German in a coffin and in uniform.

h. That upon disinterment of the remains at Krapina two (2) bodies were found. One remains were buried in a coffin with German clothing. The other remains were buried without clothing and had been placed on top of the coffin. (See Ex: "C")

i. That a tooth-chart was taken for the remains found without clothing and believed to be those of Lt. Conway basing on the evidence given by the cemetery keeper.

j. That complete skeleton was found. Right humerus broken. No trace of burning.

k. That this was the only American buried in the cemetery at Krapina.

l. That all debris of the plane had been removed by the Germans.

5. COMMENTS:

a. That the tooth-chart of Lt. Conway presently on file at this office does not correspond to the tooth-chart taken of the remains disinterred at Krapina.

b. It is the opinion of this office that there might be a possibility of an error due to the age of the first tooth-chart.

c. That this is the only American buried at the cemetery at Krapina.

STATEMENT

I, the undersigned Ivan Baliber, cemetery care taker at Krapina declare that in Spring 1945, I don't recall the date, the German soldiers brought to the cemetery the body of an American airman for burial. There was some clothing on the body and the Germans took them off, left the body completely naked. I was ordered to bury this airman in the same grave where a German soldier was buried that morning in a coffin.

Therefore in this grave are buried two men: a killed German in the coffin and above him the American airman without coffin.

I got from the Germans the name of the deceased airman as follows: 1st Lt. George Taylor Conway O-777598, which I noted and later on All Saints Day, 1 November 1945, I fixed on the gravemarker.

I recall that the deceased American was strong, large and well built man, and that one of his arms was broken.

He is the only American buried in this cemetery and no other was buried during or after the war there.

STATEMENT

Herewith I declare that on Thursday, 22 March 1945, between 1200 and 1400 hours, an American four engine plane crashed 20 meters from my home at the village Preseka near Krapina. A few seconds before the crash I saw an airman to bail out, but his chute failed to open. He fell 10 meters away from the plane and was found dead. The German soldiers were incidentally at that time in our village and took the dead man for burial at the cemetery at Krapina. I was told that five other men from that plane were rescued by the Partisans.

I saw the white star on the plane. The debris had been later removed.

The above is to the best of my knowledge.

I recall exactly the date as it was a local holiday.



STATEMENT

I, the undersigned Ivan Baliber, cemetery care taker at Krapina declare that in Spring 1945, I don't recall the date, the German soldiers brought to the cemetery the body of an American airman for burial. There was some clothing on the body and the Germans took them off, left the body completely naked. I was ordered to bury this airman in the same grave where a German soldier was buried that morning in a coffin.

Therefore in this grave are buried two men: a killed German in the coffin and above him the American airman without coffin.

I get from the Germans the name of the deceased airman as follows: 1st Lt. George Taylor Conway O-777598, which I noted and later on All Saints Day, 1 November 1945, I fixed on the gravemarker.

I recall that the deceased American was strong, large and well built man, and that one of his arms was broken.

He is the only American buried in this cemetery and no other was buried during or after the war there.

Herewith I declare that on Thursday, 22 March 1945, between 1200 and 1400 hours, an American four engine plane crashed 20 meters from my home at the village Preseka near Krapina. A few seconds before the crash I saw an airman to bail out, but his chute failed to open. He fell 10 meters away from the plane and was found dead. The German soldiers were incidentally at that time in our village and took the dead man for burial at the cemetery at Krapina. I was told that five other men from that plane were rescued by the Partisans.

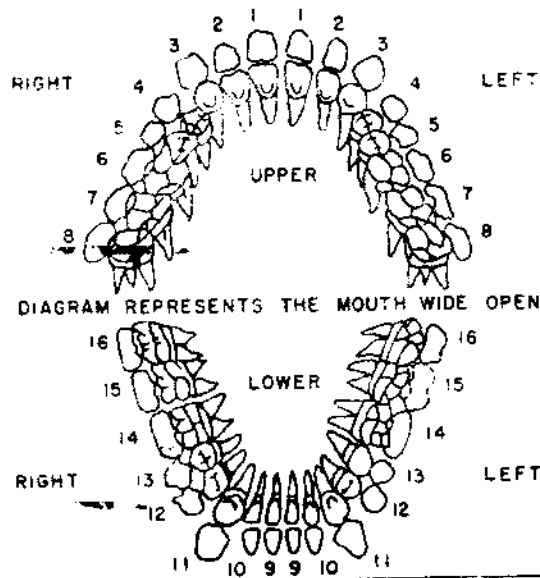


DIAGRAM REPRESENTS THE MOUTH WIDE OPEN

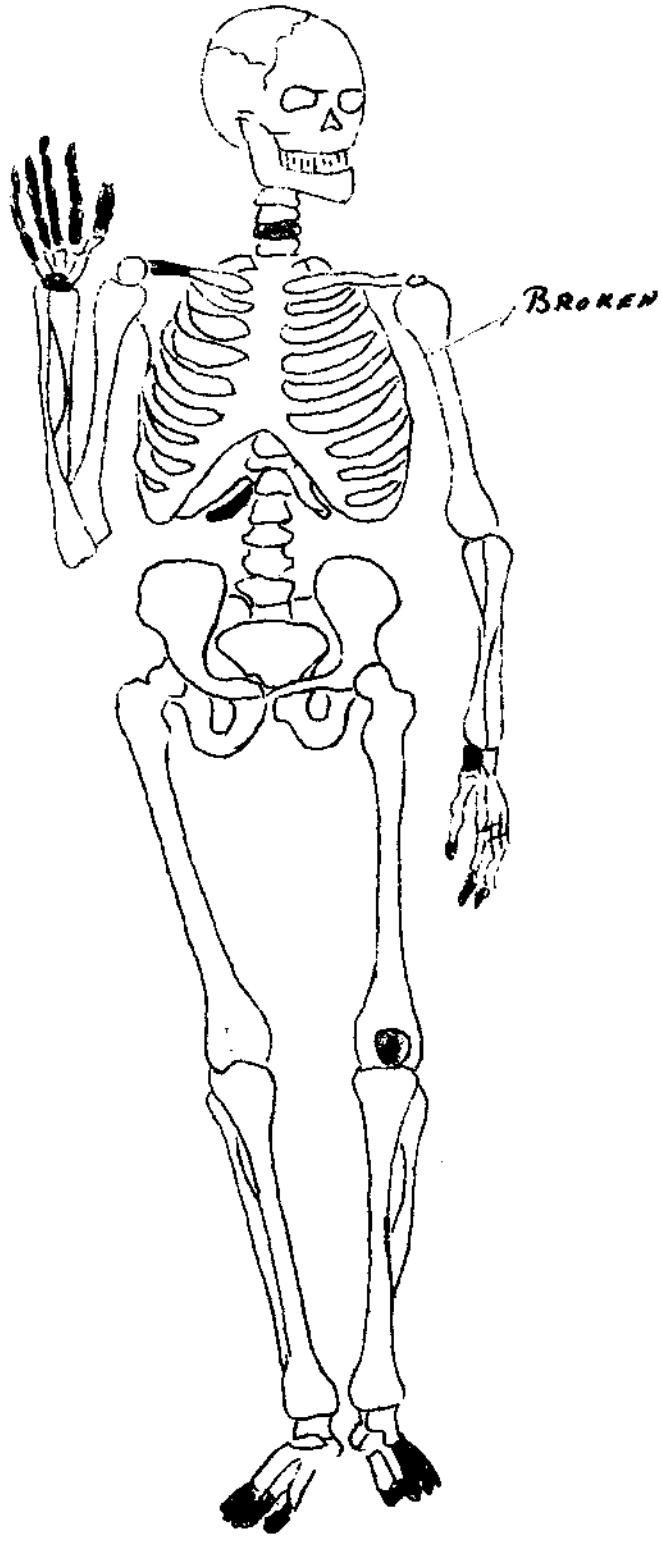

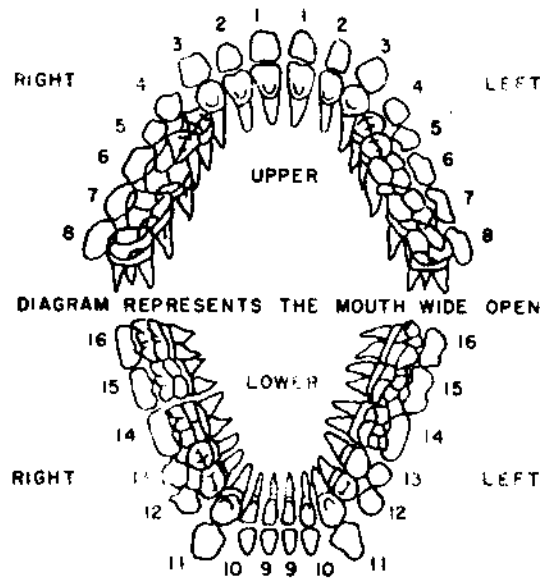

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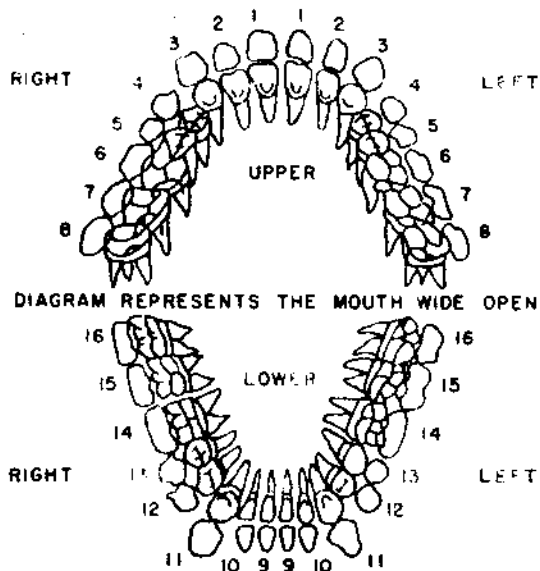


DIAGRAM REPRESENTS THE MOUTH WIDE OPEN

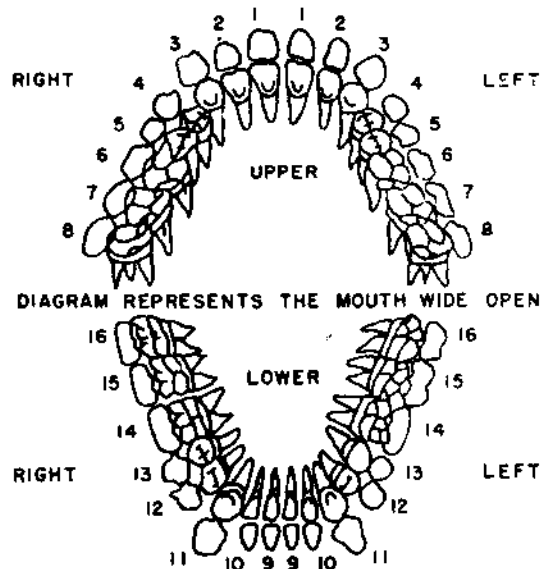


DIAGRAM REPRESENTS THE MOUTH WIDE OPEN
