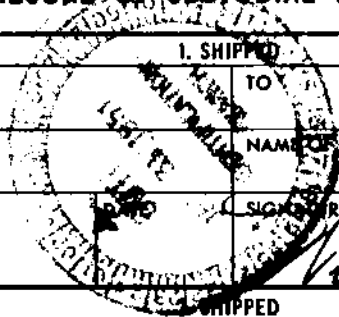

1. Submitted herewith is the Report of Investigation by this office on Believed to be Parker, Harry, killed in action as of 2 April 1945, of the 15th Air Force, organization and serial number unknown.

2. Following exhibit is attached:

a. Exhibit "A" Certificate of the People's Committee of Jarenina

3. FACTS:

a. That MACR concerning this case is not available on file in this office.

4. FINDINGS:

a. That an American fighter plane, apparently P 35, crashed on 2 April 1945 near the railway station Pevnica 5 miles North of Mariber, Yugo., Co-ords: 46 33'N - 15 41'E. (See Ex: "A")

b. That the body of the pilot was found nearby, not burned and buried in the local cemetery at Jarenina three days later. (See Ex: "A")

c. That the cemetery taker was told by the Germans that the name of the pilot was "Harry Parker" and that the plane was American. (See Ex: "A")

d. That upon exhumation the remains of an American airman were found with in skeletal state, without clothing.

e. That a tooth-chart was taken.

f. That it was impossible to identify the plane as all debris had been removed after crash.

5. COMMENTS:

A check with British G.N. & N revealed that they don't have an individual missing named Harry Parker. MACH concerning this case is not on file, however it is believed that information furnished by local authorities is correct.


6. RECOMMENDATIONS:

- a. That the disinterred remains be accepted as those of Believed to be Harry Parker.
- b. That tooth-chart taken be compared against his dental records and the finding be forwarded to this office.

7. CONCLUSIONS:

- a. That we have buried the above remains in the U.S. Military Cemetery Belgrade in the following way:

CERTIFICATE

The People's Committee at Jaremina, county of Mariber, herewith certify that an American fighter plane crashed on 2 April 1945 at about 1400 hrs., near the railway station Pesnica.

The civilians saw USA signs on the plane. The Germans gave to the grave keeper the name of the killed pilot as "Harry Parker, American officer". His papers were taken by the Germans.

The plane was flying in a formation with four other planes, from North to South. The body of the pilot was found near the wreckage, not burned. He was buried in the local cemetery at Jaremina.

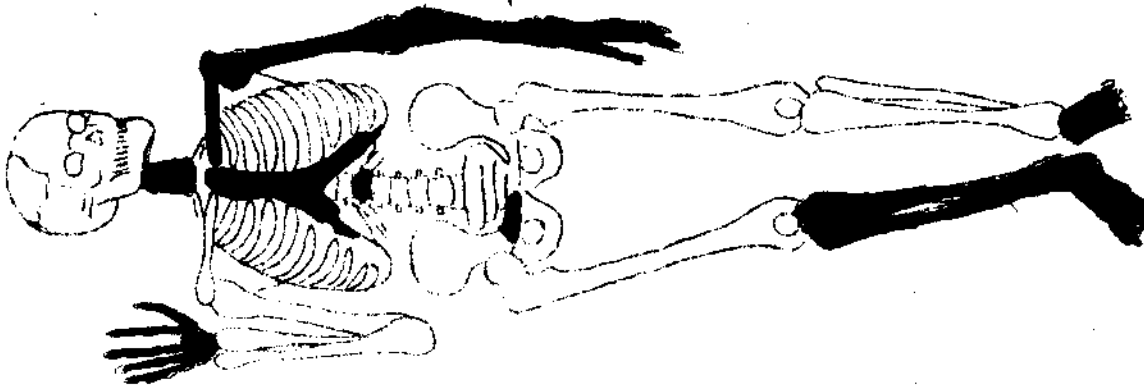
