The People's Committee at Jarenina, county of Mariber, berewith certify that an American fighter plane crashed on 2 April 1945 at about 1400 hrs., near the railway station Pesnica.

The civilians saw USA signs on the plane. The Germans gave to the grave keeper the name of the killed pilot as "Harry Parker, American officer". His papers were taken by the Germans.

The plane was flying in a formation with four other planes, from North to South. The body of the pilot was found near the wreckage, not burned. He was buried int the local cemetery at Jaranina.
