 - 3. PACTS:
- a. That MACR concerning this case is not available in this office.

4. FINDINGS:

- a. That a four engine American bomber plane made a crash landing on 11 December 1944 in a field near the village Dukovici, county Benkovac, Yugo., Co-ords: 44°00°N 15°42°D. (See Ex: "A")
- b. That seven crew members bailed out. Fix of them landed safely, while one met his death as his chute failed to open. (See Ex: "A")
- c. That three other crew members were found unhart in the plane. (See Ex: "A")
- d. That the deceased crew member was identified by local Partisans and the rescued crew members as Edward Yurochko, 33767134, by means of his tag.
- e. That the body of the deceased crew member was taken to Benkovac and buried there by the Partisans, in the local cemetery, in the family vault of Eugenic Pertis. A military funeral was given, and the survived crew members were present on it.

- \$. That the local priest at Benkovac recorded the burial in his register of death and took the tag for custody.
- That his personal effects were turned over to his purvived crew manhers.
- h. That upon exhumation the remains of a man in skelatal state were found in a coffin. No clothing. Broken extensities.
- i. That Luke Zecevic, the president of local People's Committee at Benkovac, who was Commanding Officer at Benkovac and organized the burial at the time of crash. He declared verbally that the remains of Cpl; Turochko are these found in that coffin.
- j. That the carmenter who made the coffin stated verbally that he put a stone in the coffin, which was found under the head.
 - j. That a tooth-chart was taken.
- k. That it was impossible to identify the plane as neither machine guns nor engines were found.

STATEMENT

Rerowith we declare, that on 11 Becember 1944 about 1400 hre. we saw an American bember plane drop behind the fermation and them made a forced landing at the village Bukovis, near Bonkovas. The formation was flying from North to the South.

We saw seven men left the plane. Six of them landed safely, while one mot his death as his shute failed to open. When we arrived at the place where the plane made ferced landing, we found in the plane three more even members who were safe and unburt.

The body of the airmen whose chute failed to open was taken to Bonkovac and buried in the local constery at Bonkovac with military hences by Partisons. He was identified as Cpl. Edward Yurochko.

The survived ever members attended the funeral and afterwards were transported to Zadar in order to be repatriated to Italy.

The burial was recorded in the local register of death.






