

- 1. Attention is invited to the attached report of burial of Unknown X-46, US Military Cemetery No. 1, Hamm, Luxembourg. The remains of Johnie M. Bates, 14035681, and Unknown X-46 were recovered in the same area and both bodies were in an advanced state of decomposition. The shoe size, trousers size and description of wounds of Unknown X-46 is shown on the report of burial.
- 2. It is requested that a check be made in units under your command to obtain the names of men who are carried as MIA at the time and place at which Bates became a casualty, and a similar check for the names of men reported deceased but for whom no report of burial has been received. 

TOOTH CHART

This dental chart is very important and should be filled in with great care. There are 32 teeth to be accounted for, as shown by the numbers on the chart. Beginning at the middle line in both upper and lower jaws, the teeth are arranged symmetrically on either side and classed as incisors (cutting teeth), cuspids or canines (tearing teeth), bicuspids (chewing teeth), and molars (principal chewing teeth). An examination should be made and findings charted to cover the following basic conditions: Lost teeth, crowned teeth, bridge work, fillings, caries (cavities of decay), dentures (plates), and any deformity of jaws found. 
